ACTI teams with a diverse makeup of membership travel to Uganda at all times of the year. We can match your schedule and gifts with one of our teams. Please let us hear from you!



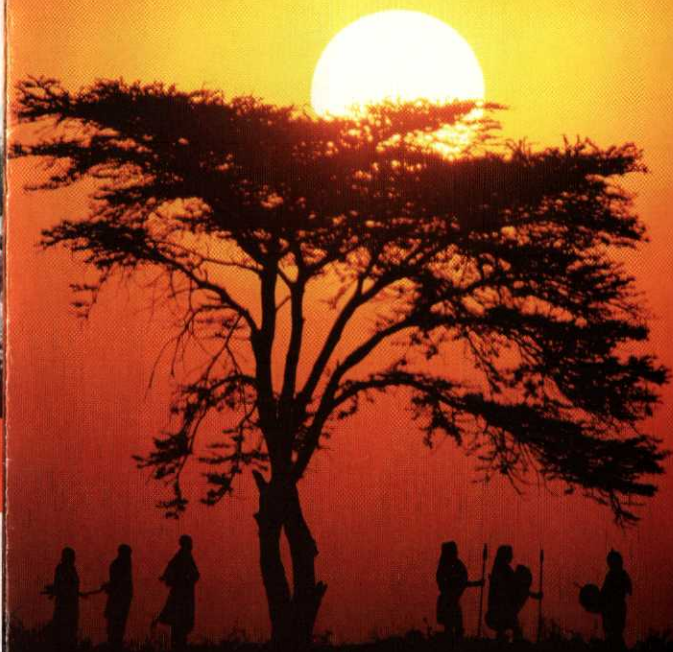

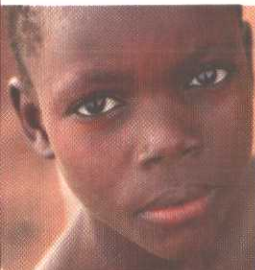

Our | HISTORY

ACTI was founded by Dr. Henry Krabbendam following a 1983 trip to Uganda. "Dr. K" as he is called by all who know and love him, was a Professor of Bible and Theology at Covenant College. He had been challenged to visit Uganda with a friend. It was a life changing experience and Dr. K returned to Uganda again and again. As he made these return trips he took some of his students with him along with interested pastors. Soon a network of those interested in Uganda began to grow with more and more making follow-up trips to Uganda. ACTI became a significant enabling ministry for short-term missions in Uganda. Typically eight or more teams are at work in Uganda during various times of the year. Over a thousand individuals have traveled to Uganda with ACTI.

ACTI assists any church group who invites us to help train, disciple, and evangelize. ACTI goes further in giving logistical aid in church planting for groups of the Presbyterian and Reformed tradition.

Dr. K and other ACTI personnel work in other African countries and even other continents as invitations are received, however, the main emphasis remains in Uganda. Uganda is viewed by many as a key to building the church throughout Sub-Saharan Africa.
