The second part of our day on Tuesday was spent at the home of Solomon Mirimu in the town of Mpige (M pe gee) which is between Kampala and the Equator on Masaka Road. Solomon is in his 30s and majored in chemistry in university. Very smart man. He is employed by my friend Rashid Luswa as head teacher at Bethel Covenant College (high school) that now has about 600 students. I preached there on Sunday, February 26.

We visited Solomon's home and met his wife Olivia. In addition to their one child, they have taken in seven other children off the street and are raising them. Solomon is quite resourceful. In addition to being head teacher at Bethel Covenant, he raises rabbits and chickens to increase his income.

Olivia had prepared a feast for us for lunch. Afterwards, they had invited some neighbors to meet us and we sat in the shade and at Solomon's request, share the gospel with the neighbors. The real purpose of the visit was to see the area and consider how we might assist in the planting of a church in the area. It appears to me that the area could be quite promising and the Ugandan's we assist will look into this for a future ministry.
