The trip to Kyamagemule is always long and bumpy but also always worth it. Fred and I both brought greetings and I taught Sunday School and preached. Afterward Fred and I spent time passing out gifts for sponsored children and a few to other children. This is always fun to see the smiles on the faces of the children. I just hate that we don't have something for every child but there are about 180 students in the school with only a dozen being sponsored.

We then shared a meal and started the long journey back to the guest house. We went through Kampala a little after 7:00 this morning so there was very little traffic. Coming back this afternoon was through a major traffic jam.
