## **Entebbe Departure**

It is recommended that you arrive at the airport about 3 hours before your flight. If there are any issues you have time to deal with them and a better chance at a good seat. They close the check-in counter one hour before the flight so three hours is effectively two. The diagram on the back shows the pathway through security to the boarding gate. The airline and passport control have copies of the *Departure Declaration* (below) which you must complete and present with your passport at passport control.


You will recognize this form (color varies) as you completed the *Arrival* version just before landing at Entebbe. The same helps are listed below because at this point in the trip, your brain is probably fried. There is a work table just before Passport Control where you can stand and fill in these forms.

Following the two restaurants bombings in Kampala on the last night of the World Cup in 2010, Entebbe officials no longer allow vehicular traffic at either the arrival or departure areas of the airport. They provide baggage carts to transport bags from arrival to the parking lot and from the parking lot to departure. At issue on departure are steps. When you reach the steps, some strong young men will take your bags to the upper level and place them on another cart so save a few coins or a 1000 shilling note as a tip.

- If you arrive more than three hours before departure, must wait outside or in the non-departure waiting area to the right of the departure area. Inside the departure screening area is a baggage scale which makes it easy to move items between your bags if needed and a Kiosk for Online Check-in. Usually there is an airline agent there to help. FYI 50 lbs/23 kilos for checked bags and 26 lbs/12 kilos for carry ons
- Security screening is to the left in the departure area. All bags, backpacks, shoes, etc., passed through X-ray, a metal detector for passengers . detector, perhaps even a handheld wand check, and in case of need, a pat down
- There are additional baggage carts past security for you to move your bags to the check-in desk
- After check-in is passport control where the Departure Declaration (other side) is taken and your passport receives an exit stamp
- You then enter the concourse waiting area with duty free shops, a cafeteria and even a frequent flyer lounge if you qualify (inquire at check-in)
- An hour or so before the flight, a call is made to pass through the gate security screening of carry-on bags plus another metal detector as you enter the secure gate area. I never rush at this since it is always warmer in that area as there is little or no air conditioning
