How to complete Customs and Border Protection Form 6059B

Distributed on the flight about 1 hour before landing

When returning to the United States, you must go through Passport Control, present your passport along with the form below to an agent. They will check your passport and perhaps ask a question or two, then give you back the passport and this form. Then go to international baggage claim and get your bags. From there go through customs and some randomly through agriculture screening. The forms below will be collected at this point. At this point there is provision to recheck your bags for your continued flight(s) or to local baggage claim. Once again you pass through personal and carry-on baggage screening and then enter the concourse area of the airport which allows you to go to your next gate or exit the airport.
