
Leonard sent me the following report and he attached a note to me (and by extension to you who help support him)

Leonard's Final report of 2015

- Radio ministry was very good, we aired out 14 messages this month and 3 people called on the name of the Lord
- Had one crusade in one of the towns in Ngora district and many prayed to receive Christ
- Shared Christmas with prisoners and 7 called on the name of the Lord. We also gave them gifts of mercy
- Some of the prisoners are pastors who are held for land disputes and they have resumed their work in prison as pastors helping inmates with Bible studies
- We continue to visit the hospital on weekly basis to share the gospel with patients and pray for them
- Visited five homes of elderly to encourage those who cannot walk to the church on Sunday.
 Others are neglected by their relatives, so we take food and encourage Christians to visit them
- Street preaching is going on in market places and drinking joints in the town centers here
- Baptized 41 new converts last month
- Preached in a wedding and also in a funeral of a pastor's mom
