This is their version of Wednesday services in the U.S. We had a great time and I am thrilled to see the church continue to grow in numbers and in faith. The school is also doing very well. It is just a primary school but is already the top achiever for primary school in that area.

This morning I spoke at Rashid Luswa's high school morning assembly. Each morning, Monday through Saturday, the whole school gathers for a few praise songs and a 15 to 20 minute devotional. I was very impressed. I also learned they do a similar event each evening at 7:30 and I hope to be involved in that too before I leave.
